Assessment

- Unit HSW1 – there are 40 questions and you need to get 24 (60%) of these right to pass the unit.
- Unit HSW2 – the risk assessment activity is marked out of 50 and you will need to achieve a mark of 30 or more (60%) to pass the unit.

60% or more is required in both units (HSW1&2) to achieve overall qualification.

Certification

NEBOSH will issue certificate for those who successfully completed the course and project.
